



Start the day by heading straight to the **Portland Visitor Information Centre**. Inside there is the **Maritime Discovery Centre** which is well worth the time to see. Be sure to stop in their café "The Captains Galley" to grab a cup of coffee.



Make your way up to the tram depot to for a ride on one of **Portland's historical trams**, which will show you the sights, along with a great commentary about the seaside town.

After this, Head out of Portland and stop in at the Bay of Whales Art Gallery (Thur \sim Sun) and the Lavender Farm (call ahead 0407 052 481) located in Narrawong.



From Narrawong, make your way to **Tyrendarra** for a stop at the **Two Rivers Gallery**. Located in an old church, the gallery showcases local artist's arts and crafts. In winter you'll be welcomed with a cosy fireplace as you browse the diverse range of artwork, a large number by Gundidjmara artists and crafts people.



From Tyrendarra, head to **Heywood** for lunch at one of the local cafes or the bakery. Check out **Heywood's Water Tower artwork** which is best seen from Heywood Park. You can also drop in to the **Heywood Model Trains** for some fun.

Drive back to Portland via **Treloar Roses**, Australia's largest rose farm, and the **Portland Strawberries** - **Farm**.



Back in Portland, immerse yourself in the lovely & expansive Botanic Gardens.

From the gardens, the main town is only a five-minute walk so ensure to stroll back in for afternoon tea at one of the harbour side cafes.

And lastly, the Creative Space Art Gallery in Julia Street is also worth a visit.
